

ERASMUS POLICY STATEMENT

The international strategy that the CIFP San Gabriel uses for the election of its partners is primarily the search for partners who can bring specific expertise to the student participating in the mobility program.

As currently the course that can participate in the Erasmus program is the CFGS Viticulture, the CIFP San Gabriel prefers industry partners like: oenology schools, wineries, vineyards...

Besides the technical part requires personal attention to the student by the person assigned as guardian in the receiving of the student.

Preferably the center choose partners geographically located at points that develops viticulture and winemaking where students can learn in addition to the technical language, other forms of cultivation and winemaking. Countries with tradition wine as France, Italy, Germany...

The main objectives that the CIFP San Gabriel is intended to achieve by participating in international mobility programs are:

- Get more complete levels of professional standards.
- Achieve greater functional mobility, have a more open mind towards learning.
- Improve social and communication skills.
- Increase the capacity of problem solving at unusual situations.
- Improve the quality of foreign language.

The CIFP San Gabriel has an I+D+i center intended to carry out projects of innovation and to improve the socio-economic development of our region. For this aspect is vital for our students the knowledge of other cultures, ways of doing and language skills.

Students interested in participate in these programs will be valued for their effort and academic ability as well as by their purchasing power in order to distribute financial resources in the most equitable way possible.

All students selected to take part in exchange programs will be chosen on the basis of merit and their potential to benefit from the experience; the CIFP San Gabriel selects students without regard to sex, race, ethnic origin, religion or social background; applications from students with disabilities are viewed on exactly the same academic grounds as those of other candidates. Our Center is also committed to making arrangements to enable students with disabilities to participate as fully as possible in student life.

The student's tutor or supervisor will be in regular contact with the student, and will be able to monitor the student's progress during the placement. On the student's return, they will have to certify that they have completed the agreed programme of work.

This system is designed to help ensure the highest quality in the organization of student placements. The host higher education institution for the period spent abroad gives full recognition.

The CIFP San Gabriel uses continuously the TIC as a tool for knowledge transfer. After the theoretical part of the studies, students access to companies which carry out the practices and after finishing the academic period become part of an employment exchange that the CIFP manages.

A new feature last May 9, 2013 the CIFP San Gabriel signed an agreement with the Madrid Open University to offer online college to allow access to university studies to persons in active employment.

The CIFP San Gabriel staff access annually and voluntarily to various courses to enhance their knowledge in various training areas.

The CIFP San Gabriel promotes student exchanges with other countries from basic education levels to high education as a source of wealth for education and acquiring knowledge of the students.

At primary teaching levels are performed annually exchanges in short periods with EU countries (Ex.: France) and higher studies so far not been carried out mobility in EU countries but with the United States (Oregon) this academic year. Very rewarding experience for the students involved in the same improving knowledge transfer and entrepreneurial capacity.

Within higher education imparted in the CIFP San Gabriel importance is given to module Business and Entrepreneurship in which students are encouraged to participate in programs and competitions sponsored by Business Associations at county level. Are conducted visits to companies and institutions so that students become familiar with the world of work and business.

The CIFP San Gabriel has agreements with financial institutions that can facilitate students' access to international mobility programs and projects that support I+D+i. The aim is to implement a Quality Management System to improve the efficiency of the School.
